- **Flying 40 Celebration** - SS&TP companies Applied Technology Associates, EMCORE, Ktech, and TEAM Technologies were presented Flying 40 awards at the annual celebration luncheon held on June 22 at Isotopes Park. The awards were given to the state's fastest growing technology-based businesses, and all four of these companies have won the award multiple times.
- **ATA Contract Information** - ATA received an additional \$380,000 contract to field test an improved far target locator system prototype for the U.S. Marines. They received the original contract in August 2009. ATA's unique sensing technologies will provide war fighters with a new azimuth determination capability that will eliminate the dilemma of precisely missing targets and improve the accuracy of U.S. Far Target Locator systems, thus making the battlefield safer for U.S. forces.
- **SLFCU Rated 5-Star** - Bauer Financial, Inc. has given its highest 5-Star Superior rating to Sandia Laboratory Federal Credit Union (SLFCU), because it exhibits overall financial superiority in such areas as capital adequacy, delinquent loan levels, and profitability. Having earned this 5-star rating for a minimum of ten straight years, SLFCU has the additional honor of being an "Exceptional Performance Credit Union". SLFCU services are available to all companies and employees in the Park.

- **IPB Growth** - Growth in Sandia's Global Security Programs located in the International Programs Building (IPB) was grounds for contractors to convert two large multi-purpose areas into offices for added staff. The 65,000 sf IPB is now at full capacity with 215 Sandians engaged in global security issues, international travel, and international protocol. The IPB provides a neutral place for Sandians, U.S. government policy makers, and other organizations to meet with foreign technical and policy experts for technical collaborations.

- **Tech Transfer Coordinator Visits** - Dr. Karina Edmonds, the new Technology Transfer Coordinator for the U.S. Department of Energy, recently visited Sandia National Laboratories and the SS&TP. Dr. Edmonds is working with the national laboratories to accelerate the process of moving technology discoveries from the labs to the private sector for commercialization and job creation.
